1. The game jersey needs to be tucked into the game shorts while the ball is live?. T or F
2. To establish a position outside the three-second lane, the player must place both feet on the playing court outside the lane. T or F
3. The three second rule is NOT in effect when a team is in control of the ball for a throw-in. T or F
4. When a player hooks and/or holds the opponent's arm usually on a rebound, what is it called? a-faking being fouled b-clamping c-mapping your opponent d-camping
5. B6 pushes A3 in the back while she is attempting a layup, the official assesses an Intentional Foul T or F
6. A Flagrant 1 foul is defined as: (choose all that apply) a. Contacting an opponent making a throw in. b. Excessive, hard and/or unnecessary contact against an opponent. c. Contact designed to negate an opponent's obvious advantageous position. d. All of the above.

8. The most important thing to identify when a screener is setting a screen is whether or not they caused the contact? T or F
9. The alternating-possession procedure starts when an official places the ball at the disposal of a player for a throw-in. The alternating-possession procedure ends, and the arrow is reversed immediately when the offensive team commits a foul while they are holding the ball for a throw in. T or F
10. The three-point field-goal line shall be a distance of 19 feet 9 inches from the center of the basket to the outer edge of the three-point line? T or F
11. Rule 10.10-5 pertains to automatic fouls committed on the ball handler/dribbler. T or F
12. Prior to the start of the game the official checking the book at the 11-minute mark notices #68 and #17 listed in the scorebook for team B. The official assesses an Administrative Technical foul. T or F
13. Palming or carrying the ball, is consistently and correctly determining whether the ball has "come to rest" which ends the dribble. T or F
14. On a free throw by A6, B3 commits a lane violation. Following the lane violation by B3, A6's free throw misses the ring and flange. a-violation on B3 b-violation on A6 c-no violation d-double violation.

The official immediately calls a Team Technical foul for “Faking Being Fouled”. T or F
20. A5’s try is in flight; the trail official has an inadvertent whistle. The try is successful, Team B will receive the ball on the end line and is entitled to run the end line. T or F
21. A1 fouls B1 on an unsuccessful shot attempt. B1 misses the first free throw, and the official allows the ball to remain live on the rebound. B4 passes the ball to B5 who scores a lay-up. A3 takes the ball out of bounds and throws the ball to A4 who is dribbling up the floor. The trail official realizes that B1 did not receive her second free throw. B1 will shoot one free-throw and play will continue with the result of the free throw. T or F
22. If a player has a Band-Aid or tape covering her ear, the official is NOT permitted to ask to see what it is covering. T or F
23. Team Technical Fouls are two free throws awarded to any player of the offended team followed by a throw-in at the 28’ line only on the tableside. T or F
24. A1 is dribbling the ball in their back court and there are 25 seconds on the shot clock. B3 and A3 commit a double foul in between the three point arc and the midcourt line in their front court. Team A will receive the ball at the point of interruption and the ball will be put back into play at the 28’ tick mark. T or F
25. A1 is dribbling the ball in the back court and there are 22 seconds on the shot clock. The coach from team “A” calls a timeout so they can reset the “10” second count. Team A will receive a new “10” second count. T or F
26. A1’s try strikes the ring and is unsuccessful. The ball is batted into the back court where A4 recovers the rebound. The shot clock operator reset the shot clock to 20 seconds. T or F
27. If an official observes jewelry in a players mouth the official will not allow the player to continue until she removes the illegal equipment. T or F
28. A1 has a throw-in on the end line, with 0.3 seconds left in the game. A1 throws the ball to A3 who catches the ball, turns, and shoots and the ball goes through the basket. The official counts the basket as it was released before the game clock horn has sounded. T or F
29. A Technical foul will be called when a player or bench personnel disrespectfully contacts an official or makes a threat of physical intimidation or harm, including, but not limited to, pushing, shoving, spitting, or attempting to make physical contact with an official. T or F
30. A post player is defined as any offensive or defensive player in the lane with or without the ball with their back to the basket. T or F
